

GRANT AGREEMENT SUMMARY for

WILDIZE FOUNDATION®

A Colorado Not For Profit Corporation

The Agreement is made between you and WILDIZE FOUNDATION to give WILDIZE reasonable assurance that you will use the grant for the proper purposes.

WILDIZE is an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code. WILDIZE is dedicated to sustainable protection and conservation efforts with respect to the Earth's diminishing wildlife, habitats and indigenous cultures; and increasing awareness, education and the exchange of ideas towards community based conservation endeavors.

Please be aware that this is only a summary of the Grant Agreement and if any conflict arises between the provisions of the Summary and the provisions of the complete Grant Agreement, the provisions of the complete Grant Agreement shall control.

I. Procedure for Applying for Grant Consideration

When you apply for a grant from WILDIZE, you must sign the Grant Agreement and complete a General Information Form (*See Attachment A*). The General Information Form provides WILDIZE with the basic information about you and why you are asking WILDIZE for a grant.

WILDIZE will acknowledge the receipt of your grant request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of WILDIZE's receipt of the General Information Form and the Grant Agreement. If necessary, WILDIZE will ask you for additional information. When WILDIZE determines that the information is complete, WILDIZE will determine whether the request is consistent with the purposes and guidelines of WILDIZE and whether WILDIZE has available funds with which to make the grant. WILDIZE will notify you of its determination in writing within sixty (60) days after your information is complete.

II. Disbursement of Grant Funds

If WILDIZE authorizes the grant, WILDIZE will notify you of the grant authorization and the timing of the receipt of the grant funds. WILDIZE will either wire the funds to your bank account or a bank account of your representative or will personally deliver the funds to you or your representative.

If you choose to have your representative receive the grant funds, WILDIZE must approve the authority of your representative in advance *in writing*. WILDIZE will determine the method of disbursement on a case-by-case basis, based upon the surrounding facts and circumstances.

III. Use of Grant Funds

You must use all the funds received from WILDIZE only for the purposes of the grant specified in your Application. Any other use of the grant funds must be authorized in advance by WILDIZE through the procedure specified in paragraph I.

IV. Repayment of Unused Grant Funds

You must repay any portion of the amount granted which you do not use for the purposes of the grant.

V. Access to Books and Records

You must maintain accurate records of the funds received from WILDIZE, as well as how you spend the funds. You must make your books and records available to WILDIZE at reasonable times.

VI. Submission of Reports

You must submit complete annual reports on the manner in which the funds are spent, compliance with the terms of the grant and the progress made in accomplishing the purposes of the grant to WILDIZE within thirty (30) days after the close of your annual accounting period.

You must prepare and submit such reports the year within which the grant or any portion thereof is received and all such subsequent periods until the grant funds are expended in full or the grant is otherwise terminated.

After you have expended the funds or fulfilled the purpose of your grant, you must make a final report with respect to your expenditures and indicating the progress made toward the goals of the grant.

VII. Grant Violations

A. Grants Improperly Used

In cases in which WILDIZE determines that any part of a grant has been used for improper purposes, WILDIZE will attempt to recover the grant funds. WILDIZE will also withhold any further payments to you until

- (1) WILDIZE recovers or restores the funds
- (2) WILDIZE has received your assurances that future diversions shall not occur; and
- (3) WILDIZE has required you to take extraordinary precautions to prevent future diversions from occurring.

B. Failure to make reports

If you fail to provide the required reports (*or provide inadequate reports*), WILDIZE will make all reasonable efforts to obtain the required report and will withhold all future payments on the grant and on

any other grant to you until you provide the report to WILDIZE.
